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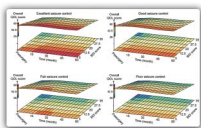
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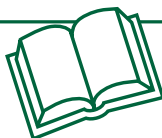
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**Cover image:** Surface plots demonstrate the relationship between quality of life (QOL) and depression scores (BDI) over time after epilepsy surgery. See page 887.

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
