Voices: Lived Experiences

Joshua Budhu, MD, MS, contributes an insightful Voices piece "COVID-19: A grim reminder of my roots." In his piece, he poignantly describes the death of his brother while in police custody at a hospital. He then makes a connection with the disproportionate impact of COVID-19, police brutality, and racism against the Black community. Dr. Budhu encourages us to engage, reminding us that "silence or inaction is tantamount to tacit approval of the systemic abuses that have contributed to poverty, lack of health care, and marginalization in our country." Dr. Budhu is Chief Resident at the combined Harvard Brigham and Women's and Massachusetts General Hospital neurology residency program and future neuro-oncologist.

Our Voices author Dr. Joshua Budhu teaches us about how hospital closures are part of the systemic barriers to health care that further burden the Black and Latino communities during the COVID-19 pandemic.
