#### **Featured Statements**

The Neurology EDI site is honored to feature a statement from the Society of Black Neurologists (SBN) condemning the ongoing murder of Black Americans and "the systemic racism that led to the conditions of their murders." In this powerful statement, the SBN describe the emotional, physical, and cognitive toll that racism exacts on Black individuals, from which Black neurologists are not exempt. They pledge to hold the AAN accountable to its core values of equity, diversity, and inclusion, and offer resources for fellow AAN members to educate themselves on the history and ongoing effects of systemic racism. **Did you know?** This section is updated regularly and is intended to highlight EDI facts and resources for anyone in neurology. In June, the Did You Know section featured information on LGBTQ+ health, including the origins of Pride (the Stonewall riots). These were a series of demonstrations led by transgender women of color, including Sylvia Rivera and Marsha P. Johnson, in protest of police brutality against the LGBTQ+ community. The section also highlighted the opportunity for further education on LGBTQ+ health through free online modules offered by the National LGBT Health Education Center of The Fenway Institute.
