

Video 1: shows patient 1 with spinocerebellar ataxia type 3. Note that the patient has antecollis associated with tilt and twist. There is no tremor, bradykinesia and the gait is normal without ataxia.

Video 2: shows patient 2 with spinocerebellar ataxia type 3. Note that the patient has significant retrocollis, normal finger nose test, tandem gait and no ataxia.
